Collection Overview**Biographical/Historical Note**

John J. McNally, Jr. was born in 1928 in Worcester, Massachusetts. He graduated from Saint John's Preparatory School in Shrewsbury and studied at the seminary of the Holy Cross Fathers in Notre Dame, IN. He later completed advanced courses at Northeastern University and at Becker College. In the late 1940's he served in the United States Army and then became President and Treasurer of Webster Enterprises, Inc., a distributor of heating supplies.

McNally first began working for John Kennedy during the 1956 Democratic National Convention while serving as Director of the Young Democrats of Worcester County (Mass.). After his work on the 1960 presidential campaign, President-elect John F. Kennedy appointed him Staff Assistant for Congressional Liaisons, a position he held until 1965. McNally was

responsible for public relations, scheduling and planning of all presidential travel, and the administrative and fiscal affairs of the White House.

In 1965 McNally returned to Webster, Massachusetts with his family and assumed the position of Director of the Economic Development Program of the Small Business Administration (SBA) for the New England area. Upon the election of President Gerald R. Ford, Mr. McNally was assigned once again to direct the operations of the "Whip Inflation Now" program. Upon the creation of the Small Business Administration's Advocacy Program, he was named the Chief Advocate of the Small Business Administration for the Northeastern US in 1976. In 1980, he was appointed Director of the SBA for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. He served as Acting Administrator of the US Small Business Administration, as Chairman of the National Small Business Council and as Chairman of the Federal Government Performance Review Board. He retired from the Federal Government in November, 1990.

Over the course of his life, McNally received numerous honors and recognitions for his community and civic activities. He served as President of the Southern Worcester County Chamber of Commerce, as Chairman of the Board of Hubbard Health Systems, Inc. and as President of Hubbard Regional Hospital in Webster. He has been an officer and director of numerous community organizations in both Massachusetts and South Carolina.

John J. McNally died on November 21, 2018 at 88 years old.

Scope and Content Note

This collection of John J. McNally, Jr. papers contains personal and professional papers relating to his work in political campaigns, as White House Staff Assistant for Congressional Liaisons, as Director of the Small Business Administration as well as other personal pursuits. These papers document McNally's role in the Kennedy and Johnson Administrations, dealing with public relations including the scheduling of White House tours and presentation of gifts, presidential travel, and the administrative and fiscal affairs of the White House. The collection spans the years from 1958-2018 and main types of records include correspondence, reading files, subject files, speech files, gift files, and photographs.

This collection is arranged into four series. Series 1. Political Campaigns contains files relating to McNally's involvement in the 1958 Massachusetts Senatorial campaign, the 1960, 1964, and 1968 Presidential campaigns. Series 2. White House Files documents McNally's work as Staff Assistant and highlights his role in various White House operations. Material in this series includes correspondence, gift files, personnel matters, reading files and requests, speech files, tours and travel files, and White House management and special project files. Series 3. Personal Files contains material relating to McNally's personal pursuits such as fundraising for the John F. Kennedy Presidential Library and other memorials and tributes to the late president and speeches he made to local organizations. Series 4. Photographs is in keeping with McNally's original filing schema consists of photograph files from his years in the White House, as well as autographed photographs from various political and civic individuals.

It is important to note that this collection incorporates the previous collection known as the White House Staff Files of 'Jack' McNally (#8.32). Much of the material was overlapping and it was determined that the collections should be combined for both ease of research use as well as to reunite several runs of files from McNally's time in the White House.
